Medical Assistance is Minnesota's Medicaid program. It is for children under age 21, pregnant women, parents of **dependent** children and the disabled who live in Minnesota and meet certain **low-income requirements**.

General Assistance Medical Care

General Assistance Medical Care is for adults between ages 21 and 64 who live in Minnesota, have no **dependent** children under age 18, do not qualify for federal health care programs and meet certain **low-income requirements**.

MinnesotaCare

MinnesotaCare is for families who live in Minnesota, do not have access to affordable health insurance and meet certain **low-income requirements**. Some children may be **eligible** even if they already have health insurance.
