Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS)

AHCCCS is Arizona's Medicaid program. It is for children, pregnant women, parents of **dependent** children and the disabled who live in Arizona and meet certain **low-income requirements**.

The Medical Expense Deduction (MED)

MED is for people who do not qualify for AHCCCS programs because their income is too high.
