Pennsylvania Medical Assistance

Medical Assistance is Pennsylvania's Medicaid program. It is for children, pregnant women, parents of **dependent** children and the disabled who live in Pennsylvania and meet certain **low-income requirements**.

Programs for Children Only

Pennsylvania's Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP)

CHIP is for uninsured children and teenagers up to age 19 who live in Pennsylvania and are not **eligible** for, or enrolled in, Medical Assistance. Children can be covered regardless of their family's income.
