Wisconsin Medicaid

Wisconsin's Medicaid is for children under age 19, pregnant women, the disabled, adults age 65 or older, women who have been diagnosed with certain cancers, or a relative caretaker of a deprived child who live in Wisconsin and meet certain **low-income requirements**.

*A deprived child is a child who has one or both parents absent from the home or has both parents in the home but one parent is incapacitated, unemployed, or an offender working without pay. The caretaker must be a relative of the child to be covered by Medicaid.

BadgerCare Plus

BadgerCare Plus is for uninsured children under age 19 and young adults who leave foster care when they turn 18 and who live in Wisconsin, regardless of income. It also covers pregnant women, parents and caretakers of children, parents who have children in foster care, farm families and self-employed families who live in Wisconsin and meet certain **low-income requirements**.
